Personal Data Controller Information Clause for the Conference Participants

Pursuant to Article 13 sections 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter the GDPR), we hereby inform as follows:

1. Data Controller

Your personal data controller is Smartt RE sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw, ul. F. Klimczaka 1, 02-797 Warsaw, Poland, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, XIII Commercial Division of the National Court Register under number 0000271568 (hereinafter the Controller)

3. Purposes of the processing of your personal data and legal basis for processing.

- a) enabling participation in the Conference, identifying the Conference Participant, preparation of a Participant list (Badges), contacting the Conference Participant, sending the Participant materials related to the Conference.

Legal basis: legitimate interest pursued by the Controller in the form of ensuring proper service of the Conference – Article 6 section 1 f) of the GDPR.

- (b) investigation or defense against claims related to the organization of the Conference.

Legal basis of the necessity of the processing for the realization of the Controller's legitimate interest, which is the possibility of establishing, investigating or defending against claims - Article 6 section 1 f) of the GDPR.

4. Right to withdraw consent

To the extent that the basis for the processing of your personal data is the consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of your consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on the consent before its withdrawal.

5. Obligation to provide data

Providing personal data is voluntary, however, failure to provide the personal data contained in the Conference participation registration form will make it impossible to participate in the Conference or contact you regarding the Conference.

In other cases, your provision of personal data is voluntary, and failure to provide such data will not result in negative consequences.

6. Information about recipients of personal data

In connection with the processing of personal data, your personal data may be provided to:

- data processors on behalf of the Controller, including:
 - a) entities providing consulting, advisory, auditing, accounting services to the Data Controller, acting on behalf of the Data Controller;
 - b) entities that provide technical services, including handling correspondence, archiving documents, developing and maintaining information systems, entities involved in organizing and overseeing the conference, including the hotel;

the above entities process data on the basis of a contract with the Controller and only in accordance with the Controller's instructions.

- public authorities and entities performing public tasks or acting on behalf of public authorities, to the extent and for the purposes that arise from the provisions of law.

7. Transfer of data outside the EEA

Your personal data will not be transferred to recipients located in countries outside the European Economic Area.

8. Personal data storage period

Data processed on the basis of the consent given will be processed, stored until the consent is withdrawn or an objection is raised.

The data will be processed for the period related to the fulfillment of the purposes of processing and for the period resulting from the law and related to the statute of limitations for claims and the period required by tax regulations.

9. Rights of the data subjects

You have the following rights:

- a) right of access, right to rectification or erasure of the personal data or right to restriction of their processing;
- b) right to data portability in the cases indicated in the GDPR;
- c) right to object to the personal data processing;
- d) right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority in charge of personal data protection (President of the Office for Personal Data Protection).

10. Right to object

You may object at any time to the processing of your personal data for reasons related to your particular situation. This right applies to data processed on the basis of the Controller's legitimate interest – Article 6 section 1f) of the GDPR.

You may object at any time to the processing of your personal data for the Controller's direct marketing purposes, to the extent that the processing is related to such direct marketing.

11. Automated processing of your personal data

Your personal data will not be processed by automated means (including profiling).
